#### Community: Movie Night/ Temple Grandin / Friday, September 23 @5pm

Staring Claire Danes, Julia Ormond, Catherine O'Hara and DavidStrathairn, *Temple Grandin* paints a picture of a young woman'sperseverance and determination while struggling with the isolating challenges of autism at a time when it was still quite unknown. The film chroniclesTemple's early diagnosis; her turbulent growth and development during herschool years; the enduring support she received from her mother (Ormond),

aunt(O'Hara) and her science teacher (Strathairn); and her emergence as a womanwith an innate sensitivity and understanding of animal behavior. Undaunted by education, social and professional roadblocks, Grandin turned her unique talent into a behavioral tool that revolutionized thecattle industry and laid the groundwork for her successful career as an author, lecturer and pioneering advocate for autism and autism spectrum disordereducation. #### MoMA Visit / Sunday, September 25, 11:30am - 1:30pm

Enjoy a private guided tour of the Museum of Modern Art'sexhibition of Bruce Conner (1933–2008). Bruce Conner was one of theforemost American artists of the postwar era. Emerging from the California artscene, in which he worked for half a century, Conner's work touches on variousthemes of postwar American society, from a rising consumer culture to the dreadof nuclear apocalypse. Working simultaneously in a range of mediums, Connercreated hybrids of painting and sculpture, film and performance, drawing andprinting, including bodies of works on paper utilizing drawing andcollage. The exhibit brings together over 250 pieces of Conner's workin various mediums. Meet at the check-in counter at MoMA, located at 11West 53rd Street between 5th and 6th avenue, where you will receiveyour free admission ticket and meet your tour guide and Felicity House staff.
