Event Descriptions

SIG: Anime, Tuesday, December 4th, 4:00—6:00pm

Participants will watch *The Tale of The Princess Kaguya*, a retelling of a Japan's most famous folktale by Legendary Studio Ghibli co-founder Isao Takahata. In the movie, an old bamboo cutter and his wife find a tiny nymph inside a bamboo shoot. They raise her as their own, calling her Princess Kaguya. As she grows she's courted by many suitors, who must complete a difficult mission to marry her. Ultimately though, she must confront her fate and receive punishment for a crime she has committed.

SIG: Writer's Room, Tuesday, December 4th, 6:00-8:00pm

The Writer's Room is a casual and quiet space where community members can come to write poems, stories, fan-fiction, or anything else they want. Feel free to bring your own writing or work on one of the prompts brought by our instructor from Gotham Writers.
